VILLAGE OF CAMERON NOTICE TO WATER UTILITY CUSTOMERS

The 1996 Amendment to the Safe Drinking Water Act (SDWA) created a public information requirement for municipal water systems. In 2023 there were no violations and no contaminants in the drinking water. None of the tests conducted during the past had exceedances of the strict drinking water standards set by the U. S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) and the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources (WI DNR).
